



Supply List for Beginning and Intermediate Oils and Acrylics

- Sketchbook-11" x 14" or 9" x 12" (optional)
- Ebony drawing pencil (optional)
- Small gray kneaded eraser (optional)
- One stick of soft brown chalk or pastel
- One clean soft piece of cloth
- Six sheets of white paper (unlined)
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Pliers (round nose-not long nose)
- Art Smock or old shirt
- Paper towels
- Bar of soft soap
- Case to carry supplies in
- Table easel (with a canvas holder on top, if preferable)
- One-round bristle brush-pure fine red sable, # 3, #4 or # 5, shorter handle, cheapest grade
 - **Do Not get Sableline or synthetic.**
- Palette-16" x 20", Plexiglass (with no holes in it)
- Palette knife with a pointy tip and a curved up handle (#4 Italy RGM Plus)
- Stretched canvas-9" x 12"
- Two-3 Packs of 5"x7" canvas boards
- Cling wrap

Additional Supplies for Oils

- Oil paints-around 1.25 or 1.35 oz tubes
 - **Do not get any jars of paint**
 - **Do not get any colors with the word hue after them**
 - Some recommended oil paint brands are Blick Artist's Oils, Winsor and Newton Oils, Liquitex Oils, and Grumbacher Pre-Tested Oils. (**Do Not get Grumbacher Academy Oils.**)
 - Cadmium Barium Yellow Light
 - Cadmium Barium Yellow Medium
 - Ultramarine Blue Deep.
 - Phthaloline Green or Thalo Green (the darkest shade)
 - Alizarin Crimson (the darkest shade)
 - Cadmium Barium Red Light
 - Crimson (Red)
 - Burnt Sienna.
 - Ivory Black
 - Large 5 oz. tube of Titanium White
- Two flat, short bristle brushes-stiff white bristles for oil painting (ex: stiff ox hair bristles), #4 and #8
- Two individual small metal palette cups, for odorless turpenoid
- Odorless Turpenoid, 32 fl. oz.

Additional Supplies for Acrylics

- Acrylic Paints-around 2 oz. tubes
 - **Do not get jars of paint**
 - **Do not get any colors with the word Hue after them**
 - Cadmium Yellow Light
 - Cadmium Yellow Medium
 - Ultramarine Blue (Deep or French)
 - Thalo Green (the darkest shade)
 - Alizarin Crimson (the darkest shade) - M. Graham Acrylic Artists' Colors has a good Alizarin Crimson
 - Cadmium Red Light
 - Naphthol Crimson
 - Burnt Sienna
 - Ivory Black
 - Large 138 ml. tube of Titanium White
 - Some acrylic brands are-Winsor Newton, Grumbacher, Blick Artists', M. Graham, and Liquitex Acrylics (**DO NOT get Liquitex Basics**).
- Jar of 237 ml. Liquitex Slow-Dri Gel Retarder (**DO NOT get a liquid retarder**)
- Two-flat, short bristle brushes-stiff synthetic bristles for acrylics, #4 and #8 (**Do not get floppy bristles**)
- Empty jar for water-the size of a 6 oz. or 8 oz. empty apple sauce jar

*****Please note, you only need to purchase the first set of Supply List items and either the additional supplies for Oils or Acrylics.**
