



Watercolor Painting Supply List

- 8 Tubes of Paints: Cadmium Yellow Light, Cadmium Yellow Medium, Cadmium Red Light, Cadmium Red Deep, Alizarin Crimson, Phthalo Green (dark), Ultramarine Blue, and Burnt Sienna
 - Do not get any colors with the word HUE after them
- A round bristle brush - number 4 or 5 medium grade red sable
- A round bristle brush - double zero or triple zero
- A rigger or script liner long bristle brush
- A mop brush
- Elephant ear sponges. Soft sponges.
- Rounded edge palette knife (not a pointy edge)
- Container of liquid frisket
- Watercolor palette, with cover – white plastic, around 16"x11", 24 wells around the edges and a large mixing area in the middle, Speedball- Robert E. Wood Palette
- Drawing board with handle and clips on it – 23"x25" – Dick Blick's brand
- Watercolor paper – 140 pound cold-press. Can get a pad of individual sheets or a glued block. Get a size about 15"x 20" or 12"x 15". Do not need to get an expensive grade.
- Sketchbook for drawing – 11" x 14" (spiral)
- Ebony drawing pencil
- 4H or 6H pencil
- Small gray kneaded eraser
- Art gum eraser
- One edge razor blade
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Paper towels
- Hair dryer
- Masking tape
- 3-5 clear containers for water
- Small spritzer bottle
- Face towel
- A small amount of large grain sea salt or Kosher salt
- Piece of fine sandpaper
- Eyedropper
- Toothbrush
- Something to carry your supplies in
