Call to Order The Public Hearing was called to order at 7:00 pm.

Public Hearing The purpose of the Public Hearing is to obtain public comments regarding two requests for Neighborhood Investment funding to be submitted to the DuPage Community Development Commission. Carolshire Park plan and imagery were displayed. Executive Director Reuter briefly explained the parameters of both projects.

1. Not to exceed \$400,000 to develop Carolshire Park.
2. Up to \$50,000 to eliminate ADA barriers at Simkus Recreation Center.

Mr. Nurul Miah, a resident at Carolshire Condominiums, addressed the Commissioners. He is happy the Park District is planning a park at Carolshire so the children will have a place to play. He hopes there will be benches for adults to gather. He would like to see a playground, fountain, grass and flower gardens. The Carolshire residents will benefit from having this park.

Adjournment Commissioner Powers made a motion to adjourn the meeting. It was seconded by Commissioner Bird.


