The following is the **Quarterly Treasurers Report** for the Carol Stream Park District for the Second Quarter (first half) of fiscal year ending December 31, 2020.

Current Fund Balance Refer to Chart A

- The opening fund balances represent audited values.
- The ancillary funds (Paving, FICA, Audit, Liability, and IMRF) are reported as part of the Corporate Fund. The District is still required to 'levy' by fund, but will record and hold the dollars in one Corporate Fund.
- The Second Quarter **Combined Fund Balance is \$6,875,544.** This includes all operating, restricted use funds, the balance of the bond proceeds, capital, and repair & replacement dollars.
  - The Second Quarter ending fund balance for all **Operating Funds is \$2,232,856.** This compares favorably to the Second Quarter of 2019 which was **\$2,042,103**. Operating funds include:

Corporate/Corporate R&R FICA
Recreation/Recreation R&R Audit
Paving & Lighting IMRF
Liability

- The **Year-to-Date (YTD) change in the Operating Fund Balance** reflects an increase of \$414,936; due to COVID, this is less than the increase of \$618,337 in 2019.
  - o District facilities did not start to reopen until July 6.
  - o Virtual programming and some outdoor programming provided some income.
  - o The first major tax installment was received in June.
- Total Capital Dollars are \$1,071,102.

#### Year-to-Date (YTD) Revenues and Expenses – Monthly Comparison – ALL FUNDS

- This report includes revenue, expense and net performance totals for ALL FUNDS therefore, operating dollars, capital dollars, cap-exempt (bond & interest dollars), and special recreation dollars are included in the totals.
- Not all funds have the same goals or 'targets'. While capital funds (specifically bond proceeds) are intentionally spent down and will result in a negative net, some operating funds (like Audit, IMRF, FICA) are targeted to maintain 3 month balances, and other operating funds (Corporate or Recreation) target a more significant positive net performance.
- Second Quarter net performance including all funds is \$2,657,547
  - Revenues are down from \$1M-\$1.2M compared to the two previous years, however due to significant expense control measures, net performance is comparable to the previous two years.
- First Half net performance including all funds is \$2,027,550
  - Net performance is comparable to the previous two years due to significant expense control measures.

#### Year-to-Date (YTD) Revenue and Expenses Compared to Budget – ALL FUNDS



- This graph reflects Operating, Capital, Cap-Exempt, and Special Recreation revenues and expenses.
- 2020 Year-to-Date revenue is 40.6% of the annual budget, with expenses at 24.4% of the annual budget.

- Second Quarter net performance for Operating Funds is \$998,925.
  - Net performance of operating funds is down by \$148,339 from the same period in 2019, and by \$243,214 from the same period in 2018; attributed to COVID.
- First Half net performance for Operating Funds is \$414,936.
  - This reflects a \$200,000 drop in first half performance from the last two years; attributed to COVID.





**OPERATING FUNDS - 5-Year History** 



This report includes revenue, expense, and net performance of only the **Recreation Fund**.

- Second Quarter net performance of the Recreation Fund (Apr-May-June) is \$20,024.
  - o The first major tax installment was received in June.
  - This quarter reflects a drop of \$434,050 compared to the same period in 2019, and similarly less than the previous historical data listed.
  - o Concentrated cost control efforts are in place to reduce expenses in line with loss of revenue.
- First Half net performance is \$434,050 lower than the previous year due to COVID.
  - o Significant cost cuts including staff furloughs and layoff have been implemented.
  - o Repairs are being limited to only those which are critical to safety, revenue production, or critical operations.
  - o Programming has been redesigned to comply with IPDH guidelines, and will focus on what the District "can provide".

The Recreation Fund is most impacted by COVID – earned revenue produces 82% of the budgeted revenue; 18% comes from taxes. Staff has worked on several forecast models to gauge the full financial impact of COVID. We estimate up to a \$600,000 loss to the Recreation Fund Balance despite cost cuts, and alternative revenue solutions. The Fund should end the year with a small positive balance, and will resume financial recovery efforts as the State continues to open under the Restore Illinois Plan.




