	Motion Passes 7 - 0 - 0
Discussion Items	A. Usage of PA Sound System by CSYFA The PA Sound System used by Carol Stream Youth Football Association (CSYFA) at Glenbard North High School's Weber Field has been an issue with Commissioner Powers for years. Looking for Board discussion on solutions to address the loud noise impacting neighbors. Division Manager Kenny met with past and current CSYFA presidents to emphasize the importance of following the established sound system usage expectations. The District's Supervisor-on-Duty (SOD) stops at Weber Field on CSYFA game days to monitor the usage of the PA System. Commissioner Powers has been supplied with the SOD phone number to report loud announcers. Executive Director Reuter reminded Commissioner Powers that many changes were implemented prior to last season and asked how has it been since then. Commissioner Powers agreed that last season was the best since he moved there. There are still some announcers who yell into the microphone while announcing. Commissioner Powers suggested we have one of our employees or the same volunteer announce the games. Commissioner Powers suggested we have given them enough warnings. If they are loud, we should eliminate the PA system entirely.
	Commissioner Del Preto asked how we can control the enthusiasm of the announcer. He is concerned if we eliminate the PA system, it would draw negative feedback from CSYFA participants, including negative remarks on social media. Commissioner Jeffery noted only football announces plays over the PA; none of the other youth sports use the PA system. Commissioner Jeffery asked about moving them to Red Hawk. Division Manager Kenny confirmed that CSYFA used a PA system at that park. Commissioner Sokolowski noted there are fewer residences in that part of town. He suggested if CSYFA can't follow the rules, we should move them to Red Hawk Park. Commissioner Jaszka stated he doesn't want to take the PA system away because a couple of adults get out of hand announcing the games. He suggested we give them a chance this fall and if we have problems, we limit announcements to the beginning, middle and end of the game rather than a play by play. Commissioner Bird noted we have only heard complaints from Commissioner Powers, not surrounding neighbors. He suggested we look into a decibel limiter. Commissioner Del Preto suggested we ask what other park districts are doing. Commissioner Gramann suggested we ask the CSYFA president if they have any ideas. We can also ask friends who also live in that neighborhood if they think it is too loud.
	 B. Weekly Happenings (oral) Commissioner Sokolowski asked about the water seeping through the water reservoir at Armstrong. Executive Director Reuter provided a written update from DuPage County (see attached).



 Commissioner Bird asked about the tax objection. Director Rini noted objection dates back to the 2014 tax year. The objection was filed by attorney on behalf of several local businesses. We believe the objection should be dismissed, and are supported in this opinion by the multiple layers of review that are in place before any taxes are released. Worse is the County could withhold \$59,000 of Special Recreation funds in funds. 	ns case ture
tax payments to the Park District. Commissioner Powers reported on the Parks Day at the Capitol and the Legislative Reception. Community Relations Supervisor Falco and Exect Assistant Greninger worked at the table in the Capitol Rotunda while Commissioner Powers and Director Rini visited the Senators and Representatives in their offices. Commissioner Gramann asked if the legislators send out newsletters. If so, we should sign up. Commissioner Jeffery reminded the Board of the Veterans Memorial Padedication ceremony on May 27 from 10:30 – 12:00 am. The Veterans Memorial Day Service is scheduled from 12:00 – 1:30. Here's a little status.

Based on the water samples taken by the County the water is seeping from the reservoir once we exceed an elevation approximately 8' above normal water elevation. The reservoir has exceeded that elevation multiple times in the past without any visible seepage. It should be noted that seeps of this kind are common in raised embankments of the type at Armstrong Park. And while it is an item that needs to be addressed the reservoir is stable.

The County has retained the services of Patrick Engineering Inc of Lisle who has expertise in repairing seeps of this nature. They are reviewing the plans and construction documents currently to identify potential causes for the seep and will recommend a plan of action to repair the seep. They have been directed to complete this work as quickly as possible. In the meantime the embankment is stable and the park access does not need to be limited. The seep is actually contained to approximately the top 6" of the soil. The sandbags that are currently in place are there to provide a counter balance to the seep which limits the amount of erosion occurring below the ground surface. We will be keeping them in-place until we're ready to initiate the repairs. We do intend to continue operating the reservoir during flood events although we will be increasing staff presence onsite to monitor.

Parking Lot Repair:

As the likely solution will include a toe drain along that side of the reservoir that will directly connect to the nearby inlet we would want to put off any permanent repairs until the final solution is determined. However, we can come and put in a patch if you want.

 Page 29 shows the net performance of the Debt Service and Capital Projects funds. The Capital Project fund reflects 'expected' and required negative performance caused by spending for capital projects.

Commissioners:

Pursuant to my responsibilities as the Compliance Officer as set forth in a Bond Record Keeping Policy (the "Policy") adopted by the Board of Park Commissioners (the "Board") of the Carol Stream Park District, DuPage County, Illinois (the "District"), on November 10, 2014, I have prepared a report reviewing the District's contracts and records to determine whether the Tax Advantaged Obligations (as defined in the Policy), comply with the applicable federal tax requirements. In accordance with the proceedings and agreements under which the Tax Advantaged Obligations were issued, the District has covenanted generally to take all action necessary to comply with the applicable federal tax rules and regulations relating to the Tax Advantaged Obligations, including covenants necessary to preserve the excludability of interest on the Tax Advantaged Obligations from gross income for federal income taxation purposes. The following sets forth a summary demonstrating the District's compliance with such covenants and expectations.

- (a) Records. I have in my possession all of the records required under the Policy.
- (b) Arbitrage Rebate Liability. I have reviewed the agreements of the District with respect to each issue of the Tax Advantaged Obligations. At this time, the District does not have any rebate liability to the U.S. Treasury.
- (c) **Contract Review.** I have reviewed copies of all contracts and agreements of the District, including any leases, with respect to the use of any property owned by the District and acquired, constructed or otherwise financed or refinanced with the proceeds of the Tax Advantaged Obligations and other records. At this time, each issue of the Tax Advantaged Obligations complies with the federal tax requirements applicable to such issue, including restrictions on private business use, private payments and private loans.
- (d) *IRS Examinations or Inquiries*. The Internal Revenue Service (the "IRS") has not commenced an examination of any issue of the Tax Advantaged Obligations. The IRS has not requested a response to a compliance check, questionnaire or other inquiry.

Based upon the foregoing, I believe that the District is currently in compliance with the applicable tax law requirements and no further action is necessary at this time. This report will be entered into the records of the District.
