The District was notified by its Auditors of changes to IRS regulations pertaining to non-cash fringe benefits. They specifically addressed employees (including WDSRA full time staff, and board members) who receive discounts for recreational programs and memberships. Certain discounts are completely restricted, such as those related to child care. Others must be taxed if the discount is above a 20%. Commissioner Gramann is glad the District is on top of this because we want to set the right example. However, she is concerned about taking away something staff depends on. Superintendent of HR noted that staff is aware. Director Rini added that there is no choice in complying with this change.

Commissioner Bird made a motion to adopt the amended <u>Personnel Policy 5-1.3</u> <u>Recreation Programs</u>. Seconded by Commissioner Gramann.

D. Approval: Natural Gas Contract

Our contract with Constellation is due to expire in November 2021. Because natural gas is a commodity, prices change rapidly and can only be locked in for a short period of time. Director Hamilton added that gas prices are going up and we can only lock in rates for a few days. Typically, rates are going down at this time of year. Commissioner Gramann suggested that we check with multiple vendors. Commissioner Sokolowski asked how long the contract is for. Director Hamilton said the best rates are usually for a three-year term. Staff is hoping to lock in a contract within 10% of our current rate.

Commissioner Gramann made a motion authorizing the Executive Director to sign a natural gas contract at his discretion. Seconded by Commissioner Sokolowski.
