### Millenium Illusions

Twist your senses at the Museum of Illusions in Chicago. Test your depth perception, challenge your vestibular system and enter an illusion of infinite space. Afterwards enjoy free time at Millennium Park. Lunch on your own at Subway.

### Blue Chip Casino

This casino in Michigan City, IN boasts of over 2,100 slot machines, 51 table games, an 8-table poker room and penny machines. Lunch on your own at a casino food venue. Valid State ID required.

### Chicago by Boat: A Day at Navy Pier

Start the day with a 75-minute architecture tour of Chicago aboard SeaDog. Learn the history of prominent skyscrapers and buildings on the river and enjoy the skyline from the lake. Lunch and free time on your own at Navy Pier.

### Rock of Ages at the Paramount

Take a trip to Aurora to see this musical story that follows a small town girl with Hollywood dreams and a big city boy chasing rock star fantasies on the infamous sunset strip. Lunch includes salad, rolls, chicken parmesan with pasta, green beans and cannoli for dessert. Pick up at ARC Center in West Chicago. Proof of vaccine or negative COVID test within 72 hours is required by the theatre.

### Tulip Time

We head to Holland, MI for the 93rd annual Tulip Time Festival. Walk through the Tulip Immersion Garden and visit the First Bloom Festival Art show. Lunch on your own at the Artisan Market. Dinner on your own at a Holland establishment.

### Chocolate and Glass

We start in Grayslake with a toffee-making class and visit to Uniquely Sweet's chocolates and Glunz Family Winery for tasting and shopping. Lunch on your own at Portillo's. We then head to Mundelein's Patterson Glassworks for glass blowing demo. Pending weather, we end trip at Tony Connoli's for cannoli-making demo.

### SHOUT: The Mod Musical

Follow the lives of five British women as they navigate the 1960's with far-out fashion, powerhouse songs and groovy dance moves, performed at the Metropolis Performing Arts Center in Arlington Heights. Dinner on your own after trip. Proof of vaccine or negative COVID test within 72 hours is required by the theatre.

### Four Winds Casino

We travel to New Buffalo, MI to play blackjack, craps, baccarat, roulette, poker, keno and over 3,000 slots. Receive a \$10 credit towards lunch and \$15 for slots. Valid State ID required.

### Simply Patsy

Mary Pfeifer delivers the sounds of the late and great Patsy Cline at this show at Starved Rock Lodge in Utica. From Patsy's first recordings to her last, this performance will bring back memories of all your favorite songs, including "Crazy" and "Walking After Midnight," while also revealing intriguing facts about the singer's life.
